Part 1 (2 marks each, 10 marks). Define each of the following in the context of the class.

- 1. Why is it (more) difficult to answer a question like "What are the last 4 digits of your student number"?
- 2. What would you say to someone who has planned some analytical evaluations of her interface design under development?
- 3. How does *consistency* impact the usability and your experience of using piazza?
- 4. How do you understand Raskin's law that "the user shall do no more work than absolutely necessary?"
- 5. In what 2 ways can one assess the conceptual distance between a user and a computer created by a particular software interface?

Part 2 (20 marks). Evaluate the following interface (see over) using the different ways we have considered. What do you find?

This is the interface that an adult (likely a parent or a teacher who may coach a team) would see when they go to register a team. Before reaching this screen, the coach, who has created an account on the FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) website, is asked to choose a role with the new team (Coach or Purchaser). In this example, you see that this person has chosen the role of Purchaser. If the person creating the team would like to coach the team (and choose that role), he or she would be given the chance to initiate a background check (as part of FIRST's Youth Protection Program (YPP), each team must have 2 adult coaches who have passed an online background check) or to continue to the team creation screen shown. Coaches do not need any technical background, because the team members (kids aged 9-14) are meant to do all the work. Coaches are well-supported by FIRST and have lots of resources.
